OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC)

In compliance with the All India Council for Technical Education (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting Technical Education) Regulations, 2009, and in accordance with the directions contained in the AICTE Circular dated 13.08.2026 regarding strict implementation of mandatory committees and notification of their details on the institutional website, the Anti-Ragging Committee (ARC) of RSR Rungta College of Engineering & Technology, Bhilai is hereby constituted with immediate effect.

The Committee shall be responsible for taking appropriate preventive, monitoring and disciplinary measures for the effective prevention and prohibition of ragging within the Institution.

1. Constitution of the Anti-Ragging Committee

The Anti-Ragging Committee shall comprise representatives from the Institution and the surrounding community, as prescribed under the applicable AICTE Regulations.

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Note: In addition to the above members, a student representative may be called, with the permission of the Principal, if required.

2. Functions and Responsibilities

The Anti-Ragging Committee shall:

1. Take effective measures for the prevention of ragging within and around the Institution.
2. Create awareness among students regarding the prohibition of ragging and its consequences.
3. Monitor areas of the campus, hostels and other locations where the possibility of ragging may arise.
4. Ensure strict implementation of the AICTE Anti-Ragging Regulations and institutional anti-ragging policy.
5. Receive and examine information/complaints relating to ragging.
6. Conduct preliminary inquiry/fact-finding whenever a complaint or incident is reported.
7. Recommend appropriate action in accordance with the applicable regulations and institutional rules.
8. Coordinate with the Anti-Ragging Squad, administration, hostel authorities and other concerned authorities.
9. Organize anti-ragging awareness programs, particularly during admission and induction/orientation periods.
10. Ensure that students and parents are made aware of the consequences of ragging.
11. Maintain records of anti-ragging activities, complaints, inquiries and action taken.
12. Submit reports to the competent authority whenever required.
13. Take all other measures necessary for effective prevention and prohibition of ragging.

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3. Anti-Ragging Squad

A separate **Anti-Ragging Squad** shall be constituted by the institute **Committee Member (Coordinator)** for the purpose of maintaining continuous vigil, surprise inspections and immediate response to any incident or information relating to ragging.

The details of the Anti-Ragging Squad shall be notified separately and shall be made available on the official website of the Institution.

4. Anti-Ragging Undertaking

All students and their parents/guardians shall be required to comply with the applicable anti-ragging undertaking requirements prescribed by the regulatory authorities.

The Institution shall maintain appropriate records of such undertakings and compliance.

5. Prevention and Awareness Measures

The institute **Committee Member (Coordinator)** shall undertake appropriate preventive measures, including:

- Anti-ragging awareness programs.
- Display of anti-ragging notices and contact details at prominent locations.
- Awareness during student induction/orientation.
- Sensitization of faculty, staff and students.
- Monitoring of vulnerable locations.
- Dissemination of information regarding the consequences of ragging.
- Immediate reporting and response mechanism.

6. Complaint and Reporting Mechanism

Any student, parent, faculty/staff member or other person may report an incident or suspected incident of ragging through the institutional anti-ragging mechanism.

All complaints shall be dealt with promptly and in accordance with the applicable AICTE Regulations and institutional procedures.

7. Confidentiality and Protection

The Committee shall maintain appropriate confidentiality of complaints and proceedings, wherever required, and shall take necessary measures to protect complainants and witnesses from intimidation, victimization or retaliation.

8. Action on Ragging

Any incident of ragging shall be dealt with strictly in accordance with the applicable AICTE Anti-Ragging Regulations, institutional rules and applicable law.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the incident, appropriate disciplinary and/or legal action may be initiated by the competent authority.

9. Tenure

The Anti-Ragging Committee shall remain in force for the Academic Session 2026–27 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

The competent authority may reconstitute or modify the Committee whenever required.

10. Website Disclosure

This Office Order shall come into force with immediate effect.
